Scholarships and Grants for the Class of 2022

All scholarships are partial and will be applied to the recipient's tuition for the current academic year. Although an applicant may apply for more than one scholarship, only one scholarship is awarded to any student.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are awarded for outstanding academic achievement and ability based on the results of the Scholarship/Entrance Examination and school records.

ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP

The Alumnae Association of Mount Saint Joseph Academy awards the scholarship to an applicant who is the daughter of an alumna and who ranks in the first quintile of those tested.

ART SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship is awarded for art talent based on a basic art test, a portfolio of drawings, and the results of the Scholarship/Entrance Examination.

MAGUIRE SCHOLARS PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

Established by the Maguire Foundation to provide applicants with financial need scholarship assistance to ensure a quality education and to ease the financial burden. The mission of the Foundation is grounded in the teachings of St. Ignatius Loyola that "we are women for others". Therefore, community service participation is expected for those in the program. Continued eligibility is dependent upon maintaining a "B" average, demonstration of financial need and adhering to established behavior guidelines set forth in the student handbook.

MOTHER ST. JOHN FOURNIER SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to minority students who have demonstrated academic achievement, are active participants in the life of their school and act as role models to their peers.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Piano, voice, and instrumental scholarships are awarded for outstanding musical ability based on a personal audition and the results of the Scholarship/Entrance Examination.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Established in honor and memory of those Sisters of St. Joseph who taught at Cecilian Academy and the Holy Child Parish School in Philadelphia. An applicant who qualifies for admission to Mount Saint Joseph Academy, and who has a parent who is either an Honorably Discharged veteran of a uniformed military service of the United States; a full-time serving member of a law enforcement agency or fire department; or who has died while serving in one of the above is eligible. The applicant with the highest score in the Scholarship/Entrance Examination who meets these criteria will be awarded the scholarship.

ALEXANDRA DUZINSKI '99 MEMORIAL GRANT

Established by Stephen and Roseanne Duzinski, family and friends. It is awarded to a student interested in the performing arts. The student must qualify for admission and demonstrate financial need. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

CATHY FITZSIMMONS '70 GRANT

Established by Cathy Fitzsimmons '70 to provide financial assistance to an applicant who comes from a single-parent household and who demonstrates financial need. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

Eugenia F. Comerford '37 Alumnae Grant

Established by the Alumnae Association, this grant is awarded to the daughter or granddaughter of an alumna who qualifies for admission to the Mount and who demonstrates financial need. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

'A FRONT ROW SEAT TO LEARNING' GRANTS

Established to provide financial assistance to applicants who strive to reach their fullest academic potential and who can benefit from a strong educational and caring environment. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

THE HAIN FAMILY AWARD

Established by the Hain family, this award provides financial assistance to an applicant who demonstrates financial need and who has excelled in extracurricular activities while in grade school. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

SISTER MARY DACEY, SSI GRANT

Established in honor of Sister Mary Dacey, former President of Mount Saint Joseph Academy, this grant will be awarded to an applicant who qualifies for admission to the Mount and who demonstrates financial need. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

STEPHANIE ARIZIN '99 MEMORIAL GRANT

Established by the friends and family of Stephanie Arizin '99. The grant provides financial assistance to a student who qualifies for admission and demonstrates financial need. To be considered, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.
