

All scholarships are partial and will be applied to the recipient's tuition for the current academic year. Although an applicant may apply for more than one scholarship or grant, only one scholarship or grant is awarded to any student. To be considered for a grant, the applicant must qualify for financial aid.

## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are awarded for outstanding academic achievement and ability based on the results of the Scholarship/Entrance Examination and school records.

### ALUMNAE SCHOLARSHIP

The Alumnae Association of Mount Saint Joseph Academy awards the scholarship to an applicant who is the daughter of an alumna and who ranks in the first quintile of those tested.

### ART SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship is awarded for art talent based on a portfolio of drawings and the results of the Scholarship/Entrance Examination.

### MAGUIRE SCHOLARS PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

Established by the Maguire Foundation to provide applicants with financial need scholarship assistance to ensure a quality education and to ease the financial burden. The mission of the Foundation is grounded in the teachings of St. Ignatius Loyola that "we are women for others". Therefore, community service participation is expected for those in the program. Continued eligibility is dependent upon maintaining a "B" average, demonstration of financial need and adhering to established behavior guidelines set forth in the student handbook.

### MOTHER ST. JOHN FOURNIER SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to minority students who have demonstrated academic achievement, are active participants in the life of their school and act as role models to their peers.

### MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Piano, voice, and instrumental scholarships are awarded for outstanding musical ability based on a personal audition and the results of the Scholarship/Entrance Examination.

### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Established in honor and memory of those Sisters of St. Joseph who taught at Cecilian Academy and the Holy Child Parish School in Philadelphia. An applicant who qualifies for admission to Mount Saint Joseph Academy, and who has a parent who is either an Honorably Discharged veteran of a uniformed military service of the United States; a full-time serving member of a law enforcement agency or fire department; or who has died while serving in one of the above is eligible. The applicant with the highest score in the Scholarship/Entrance Examination who meets these criteria will be awarded the scholarship.

### CATHY FITZSIMMONS '70 GRANT

Established by Cathy Fitzsimmons '70 to provide financial assistance to an applicant who comes from a single-parent household and who demonstrates financial need.

### DONNA HANSON '88 MEMORIAL GRANT

Established by the family of Donna Hanson '88 in her memory to provide financial assistance to an applicant who demonstrates financial need and is involved in extracurricular activities while in grade school.

### EUGENIA F. COMERFORD '37 ALUMNAE GRANT

Established by the Alumnae Association, this grant is awarded to the daughter or granddaughter of an alumna who qualifies for admission to the Mount and who demonstrates financial need.

### 'A FRONT ROW SEAT TO LEARNING' GRANTS

Established to provide financial assistance to applicants who strive to reach their fullest academic potential and who can benefit from a strong educational and caring environment.

### JIM AND ANNA MAE CASSIDY AWARD

Established by Lois Trench-Hines '60 in honor of Jim and Anna Mae Cassidy of Ambler. This award provides financial assistance to an applicant who demonstrates financial need and who has shown notable participation in extracurricular activities while in grade school.

### KELLY ANN O'CONNOR MEMORIAL GRANT

Established in memory of Kelly Ann O'Connor '96 to provide financial assistance to an applicant who demonstrates financial need and combines a fun loving spirit with concern for others.

### MARTIN SINON MEMORIAL GRANT

Established in memory of Martin A. Sinon by his family, relatives, and friends in order to provide financial assistance to an applicant who qualifies for admission and demonstrates financial need.

### SISTER KATHLEEN BRABSON, SSJ GRANT

Established in memory of Sister Kathleen Brabson, SSJ, former President of Mount Saint Joseph Academy. The grant provides financial assistance to an applicant who qualifies for admission and demonstrates financial need.

### SISTERS OF SAINT JOSEPH MEDAILLE GRANT

Established in honor of the Sisters of Saint Joseph in order to provide financial assistance to applicants who qualify for admission and demonstrates financial need.

### STEPHANIE ARIZIN '99 MEMORIAL GRANT

Established by the friends and family of Stephanie Arizin '99. The grant provides financial assistance to an applicant who qualifies for admission and demonstrates financial need.
